Start and courses

Start is on the other side of Panuntie less than 200m. When crossing the street you shall follow the safe passage accross the street. Competition course is on smooth gravel and asphalt paths, but partly also along the walkway North side of Panuntie. **You shall watch other walking persons and specially bicycles.**

Map and punching card

Scale 1:4000, equidistance 2m

Map is in plastic bag. You will get pouching card 30s before start and map at the start moment. In Elite-class competitor gets two punching cards for controls 1-14 and controls 15-29.

Maps will be collected at the Finish until the start time of the last competitor at 14.40. Maps and solution maps will be available at the Info desk in the Competition Centre.

TOE-punching and punching card

At each control competitor makes TOE-punch and manual punching on the punching card. In Elite class competitor gives the first card to the organising official after control 14. Competitor brings the second punching card to the Info-desk at competition centre after Timed Controls.

Competitor brings also the TOE punching cards together with the manual punching card to the Info desk at the competition centre.

Start lists

Start list is available at the competition centre Info desk, IOF Eventor and FinTrailO 2022 website.

Toilets and social facilities

There is a canteen, toilets and social facilities in the competition centre. Guidance from the Info desk.

Forbidden areas

The street panuntie North-East of the competition centre is forbidden area except the walkway to the start. Forbidden areas are marked on the map below. They are marked with STOP signs or STOP plastics.



During the competition competitors shall stay away from the Forbidden areas STOP signs along the courses. It is strictly forbidden to cross the street Panuntie (except on the way to Start and returning from Finish).
