COMPETITION CENTER

In off-road conditions at address Luolavuorenpolku, Turku. There is no WC or canteen in the competition center. There are several gas stations, shops and food stores in the vicinity, where these services can be found.



REGISTRATIONS

You can register for the A series on site from 11:30 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. Payment €5/competition in cash, card or with the most common "liikuntaetu".

MAP AND TERRAIN

Map 1:3,000 / 2 m, ISSprOM 2019-2. Completed on 23 March 2024. Urban forest, park and yard areas

TEMPO

All classes have 6 stations with 5 tasks each. Zero tolerance 4 m.

The distance to the start is 180 m. On the approx. 300 m route, there is one approx. 10 m uphill, otherwise flat or gentle downhill. The path is a gravel road or asphalt, some of which may still have ice/slush.

In Tempo, the ANT program is used for timing and recording of markings.

PREO

26 tasks, distance 400 m. Ascent about 5 m. Free punching order.

The route is a gravel outdoor trail, some of which may still have ice/slush. There is 1 timecontrol on the course with 3 tasks. It is located approx. 20 m before the first Tempo-station and is therefore performed before the Tempo competition.

It's 450 m from last Tempo station to PreO start. From the finish to the competition center 650 m.

Maximum time 90 minutes. 100 minutes for P-certificate holders.

The TOE punching system is used in the competition, and the competitor receives the TOE-chips from the competition office and hands them over at the finish. In case problems with TOE-punching, competitor should use safety pin for punching. Punching grid printed behind the map. If you have punched with safety pin, bring your map to the competition office. If there is both electrical and manual punching, TOE-punching is primary.

Decision poles only for controls with more than one flag. Zero tolerance 4 m.

NUMBER BIBS

Number bibs are used in the competition (also in the A series). Bibs and safety pins (if you haven't found your own) can be found from the race office.

PRICES

In the competition classes, the best of both competitions will be awarded. No prizes in the A-class.
